

To establish itself as a Logistics Platform for Humanitarian Assistance in order to enable the facilitation of activities such as, the reception, handling, storage and the redistribution of provisions & equipment, as well as the deployment of human resources, without contravening any other related activity, for an efficient humanitarian assistance management afore national and international emergencies and hence, fortifying countries of the region.

The CLRAH Humanitarian Logistics Facilitation Platform

Latin American Countries, as well as the Caribbean continue to be affected by adverse events, which have ended in major disasters, linked to the multiple threats that prevail in the region. The humanitarian aid that friendly countries provide, many times are not transferred in a timely manner and with the effectiveness required onto the affected country.

The CLRAH as a logistics platform for Humanitarian Assistance seeks to fortify said response by contributing, through infrastructure, logistics & knowledge, as well as efficiency in the deployment of humanitarian resources, inasmuch in the country, as in the region.

The CLRAH is located within the Panama Pacifico area, embracing 6.12 hectares of land located "in parallel" to the tarmac of the Panama Pacifico International Airport bearing a high connectivity trait with the most important containerized loading ports located, inasmuch in the Pacific (Panama), as in the Atlantic (Colon).
