AMATEUR RADIO LICENSE ISSUANCE PROCESS FOR FOREIGNERS

The amateur radio certificate or license and all your documents in english must be translated by an official translator, and must be duly stamped and apostilled by the embassy where it was issued and/or the panamenian Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

For the processing of your amateur radio license you must submit a copy of your certificate or license and any other document must be translated into spanish by a Certified Public Translator. These documents must be stamped and apostilled by the embassy of the country of origin or where it was issued.

You must also fill out the license application form, submit a copy of your passport, a copy of your Permanent Resident Card and two (2) passport size photographs.

To apostille your documents, you must go in person, to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, However, previously scheduled appointments will be attended through www.mire.gob.pa you will receive a response within a maximum of 72 hours. Payments must be made directly to Bank National and not through the ACH system.
